### **Introduction:**

Most pastors and churches appreciate free publicity and creative ways to reach new people; the [comm!tted.net](http://comm!tted.net) website can serve as an excellent resource to serve churches in promoting their agenda and programs.

### **Background:**

Marriage CoMission initiatives best serve the faith community as a “catalyst” and support resource to build out the marriage and family “capacity” in various churches. Churches in your community can register their church at [comm!tted.net](http://comm!tted.net). Individuals will be able to seek marriage/family help, (searching by city or zip code). They will be able to locate a church within their community and click right through to that church’s website.

### **Strategy:**

- Consider registering on [comm!tted.net](http://comm!tted.net), yourself/your Marriage CoMission City Initiative as an administrator – strengthening your support role to the Faith Community.
- Encourage/equip churches to register at [comm!tted.net](http://comm!tted.net) for gifted resources and other support

This is a great way to serve churches by bringing additional “traffic” to them, but also a “subtle” challenge to the church as to whether inquirers will find any specific marriage and family help once they check out this church! This can often prompt dialogue about how the Marriage CoMission initiative can support the church in helping expand marriage services through this church.

- Connect individuals, couples and families with churches in your community
- Provide churches with added opportunity to promote their ministry offerings
- Offer pastors free sermon downloads and other resources
- Provide pastors with this referral website as an extension of pastoral counseling (several hundred articles can be a supportive resource to those needing help)
